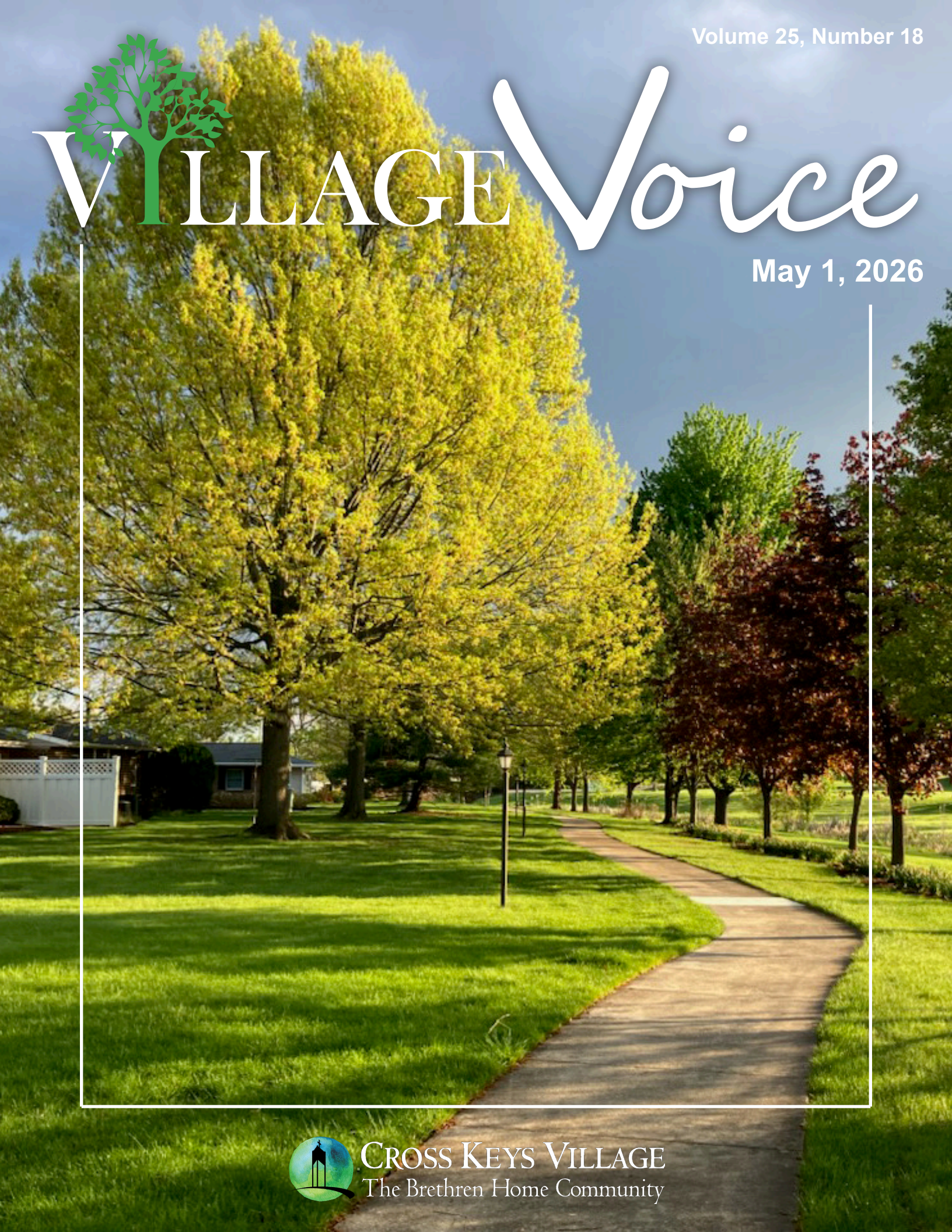

Emergency Messaging System Test

In the event of severe weather, civil disturbance, or other unusual circumstances, you may receive a call and/or text from our automated system with a prerecorded message of what to do and important updates. We will be testing our new system again for all Villagers and team members on **Wednesday, May 6, around 9:00 am**. In addition to Villagers and team members, we have also programmed phones at various locations throughout the campus to alert those near a CKV phone that a message has gone out.

The message will state that “This is only a test.” Part of this test is to ensure that we are reaching all team members and Villagers. We are still working with the vendor to update the caller ID for the new system. Please make sure to have the number 224-464-4460 entered in your contacts list. The call shows that it originates from Wheeling, IL. Some spam call-blocking software may prevent the call from coming through or leaving messages, so entering this number as a recognized contact will help with that. You can title it as “CKV Alert” or something similar to pop up in your contacts list.

Cell phone users should receive a text message. If you do not have a landline phone, then a call should also come through to your cell phone. If you have a landline phone, then the call should be received there. If you do not receive the call or text or have difficulties with the message, please contact the Information Services department at ext. 7200 or enter a work order in Uniguest so we can look into your issue.

Scheduled Wi-Fi Interruption Information Services, Ext. 7200

The IS team will be performing required maintenance on the campus wireless network on **Monday, May 4 at 2:00 pm**. Wireless internet access will be unavailable for approximately 1 to 2 hours. This will impact all devices that use the wireless network including smartphones, smart TVs, laptops, tablets, and other wireless devices. Wireless access will automatically resume once the maintenance is completed with no action required on your part.

Occasionally, a disruption in wireless service will cause you to be logged out of Uniguest. If this occurs, you may log back in using the following information:
