Elder Justice Act: Under this regulation it is the obligation of anyone who works for, or contracts with a long term care community to report to local law enforcement, and to the Secretary of Health and Human Services, their reasonable suspicion of crimes committed against nursing home residents. This reporting must happen in a timely manner. If the events that cause

the suspicion—Result in serious bodily injury, the individual shall report the suspicion immediately, but not later than 2 hours after forming the suspicion; Do not result in serious bodily injury, the individual shall report the suspicion not later than 24 hours after forming the suspicion.

Please be sure to inform all of your employees who, in the course of business, are present on our community's campus, are aware of these obligations. Enclosed you will find a copy of our poster to share with your appropriate employees.
